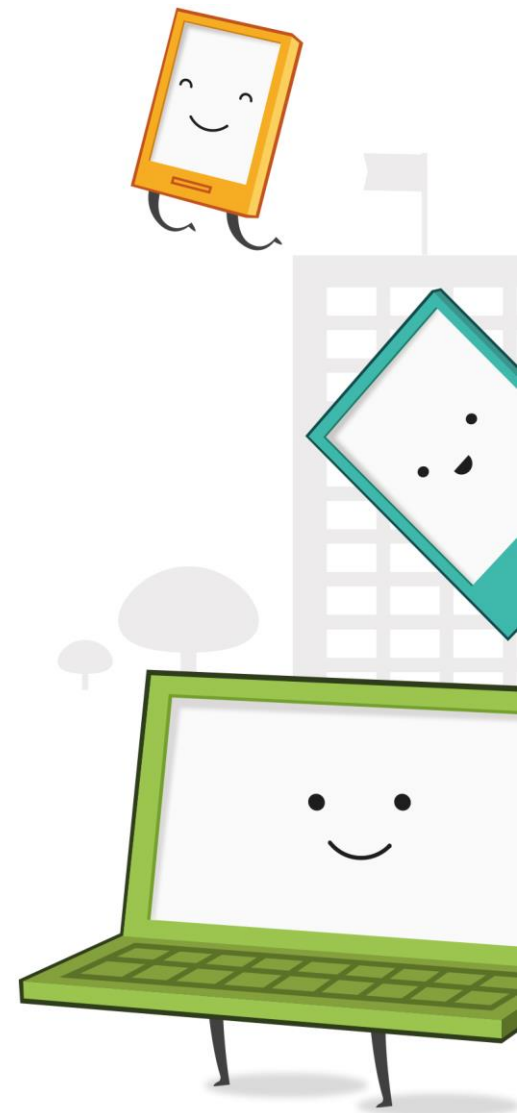




Primary Resources for August 2016

International Day for the Remembrance of the Slave Trade and of its Abolition – 23rd August

International Day for the Remembrance of the Slave Trade and its Abolition is on August 23rd each year. The day is designated by UNESCO as a way of remembering the transatlantic slave trade. This date is significant as it was during the night of August 22nd – 23rd that an uprising began on the island of Saint Domingo (now Haiti) that set forth events that were a major contributory factor towards the abolition of the transatlantic slave trade.
